The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a workshop to provide an update on activities conducted under the Order Instituting Informational Proceeding on Distributed Energy Resources (DER) in California's Energy Future. This workshop will primarily focus on CEC's use of advanced metering infrastructure data for DER planning, including demand flexibility, as well as the opportunities and challenges for front-of-the-meter DERs in California.

Background

California has embraced the adoption of distributed energy resources as an important strategy to increase renewable and zero-carbon resources and support transportation and building electrification. In its role in gathering and analyzing critical energy system data to support energy

policy development, the CEC launched an informational proceeding in 2022 to further explore, collect information, conduct assessments, and support recommendations for the role of DERs in California's energy future. This proceeding primarily investigates trends in DER technology, capability, deployment, cost, and customer value and adoption. It also investigates policies and regulations to optimize DER benefits and value in support of advancing state goals for decarbonization, resilience, affordability, and environmental justice and equity.
