Project Description: The City of Santa Clara's Pico Power Project is a natural gas-fired, combined-cycle electric generating facility. The 3-acre project site is located west of the intersection of Lafayette Street and Duane Avenue and immediately north of SVP's Kifer Receiving Station in the City of Santa Clara, Santa Clara County, California. The new combined-cycle facility is expected to generate 122 megawatts (MW) under nominal conditions, with the ability to generate up to 147 MW with supplemental duct firing.

On <u>September 9, 2003</u> the California Energy Commission approved the above-described project pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary of Resources under Section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code.


