In our letter to you dated February 19, 2004, the City of Glendale Water & Power Department (GWP) indicated that it was electing not to claim specific purchases for the year ending December 31, 2003 and therefore, was not submitting any schedules pertaining to the Annual Report under the Power Source Disclosure Program applicable to Retail Providers. Instead, GWP is claiming the California Power Mix for that portion of its electricity.
