SMUD continues with wind power expansion

S even new wind turbines are bringing five additional megawatts of electricity to Sacramento. SMUD's Solano Wind Project now has 23 turbines generating 15 megawatts of electricity.

The project is expected to expand to 100 megawatts in the next two years – enough to power 30,000 single-family homes for a year.

Located in the Montezuma Hills near Rio Vista, the project is situated in one of the best wind sites in California. The turbines make the most of the stiff winds that blow in from the coast, squeeze through the Carquinez Straits, then spill into the Delta. Winds in the Montezuma Hills are strongest from May through September, producing the most energy when electricity needs in Sacramento are highest.

SMUD first installed wind generation on the property in 1994. The recent expansion will continue as the SMUD Board of Directors has made a long-term commitment to affordable, renewable energy sources.

Your free shade trees, stakes, ties and fertilizer will be delivered to your door, usually within 10 days of the site visit from the community forester.
