Dear Assembly Member Calderon:

On November 22, 2005, Walnut Creek Energy, LLC, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Edison Mission Energy, submitted an Application for Certification (AFC) to construct and operate a 500 megawatt simple-cycle power plant, the Walnut Creek Energy Park (WCEP), in the City of Industry. The WCEP is designed as a peaking facility to meet electric generation load during periods of high demand, which generally occur during daytime hours, and more frequently during the summer than other portions of the year.

The AFC is currently being reviewed to determine if it contains the information required by Energy Commission regulations. When the application is deemed data adequate, the Energy Commission will start the discovery and analysis phases of the review of the WCEP. Over the coming months, the Energy Commission will conduct a number of public workshops and hearings on the proposal to determine whether the WCEP should be approved for construction and operation and under what set of conditions. These workshops will provide the public and local, state and federal agencies the opportunity to ask questions about, and provide input on, the proposed project. The Energy Commission will issue notices for these workshops and hearings at least 10-14 days prior to the meeting.

We are available to brief you and your staff on the Energy Commission's power plant review process and the specifics of the WCEP application.
