

VSE's PROPOSED SCHEDULE

In accordance with the Committee Notice of Public Informational Presentation and Site Visit, dated February 7, 2006, Valle del Sol Energy, LLC (VSE), a wholly owned subsidiary of Edison Mission Energy hereby files its Proposed Schedule for Committee Consideration in developing its Scheduling Order. The following Proposed Schedule recognizes that the only critical path item necessary for Staff to issue its Preliminary Staff Assessment (PSA) is the Preliminary Determination of Compliance (PDOC) to be issued by the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD). Therefore, we propose that the Scheduling Order be developed to allow Staff 30 days to prepare its PSA from the time the PDOC is docketed. Similarly, we recognize that the Final Determination of Compliance (FDOC) is the only critical path item to Staff issuing its Final Staff Assessment (FSA). Therefore, we proposed a schedule that allows Staff 25 days after the FDOC is docketed to modify its PSA Air Quality section, should modification be required, in order to issue the FSA. VSE believes that all of the outstanding issues relating to Air Quality will be resolved by the SCAQMD FDOC process and therefore request the Scheduling Order be designed to allow the parties to proceed with the CEC process and to hopefully resolve any issues unrelated to air quality while the FDOC process is proceeding.
