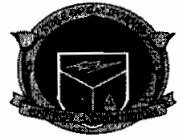

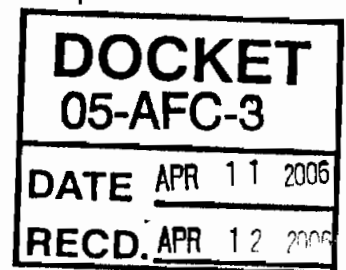
Notice of Data Response and Issues Resolution Staff Workshop for the Sun Valley Energy Project (05-AFC-3)

Purpose

The staff of the Energy Commission will conduct a Data Response and Issues Resolution Workshop for the proposed Sun Valley Energy Project. The workshop will allow the applicant, interested agencies, and the public to discuss responses submitted by the applicant to staff's data requests issued on March 15, and March 30, 2006, and to work toward resolving project issues. Subjects to be discussed include: Air Quality, Biology, Cultural Resources, Land Use, Public Health, Socioeconomics, Soil and Water Resources, Traffic and Transportation, Visible Plume Modeling, Visual Resources, and Waste Management. Other areas as necessary may be discussed.

Background

On December 1, 2005, Valle del Sol Energy, LLC, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Edison Mission Energy, filed an Application for Certification for the Sun Valley Energy Project, seeking approval from the Energy Commission to construct and operate a nominal 500 megawatt simple-cycle power plant near Romoland in unincorporated Riverside County. On February 1, 2006, the Energy Commission accepted the AFC as complete, which initiated Energy Commission staff's independent review of the proposed project. The proposed project site is an approximately 20-acre parcel at 29500 Rouse Road, and adjacent to Mathews Road, currently optioned to Valle del Sol Energy, LLC.
