Resolution Supporting Development of The Sun Valley Energy Project

WHEREAS, the Edison Mission Group has proposed a new 500-megawatt peaker power plant to serve peak electricity demands in central Riverside County and Southern California; and

WHEREAS, more than 8,000 megawatts of new generation has been permitted, but few companies are willing to risk construction due to uncertain state energy policies; and

WHEREAS, development of a power plant would generate nearly 190 construction jobs and 9 full-time operating jobs; and

WHEREAS, there would be enough electricity produced from the Edison Mission Group's Peak-Load Power Plant to power 160,000 home air conditioners; and

WHEREAS, Edison Mission Energy is committed to investing \$250 million for the development, construction and maintenance of a power plant; and

WHEREAS, construction and operation of the project would generate more than \$14 million in tax revenue for the region; and

WHEREAS, the location of the power plant would eliminate the need for stringing extensive power lines from other regions into our area; and

WHEREAS, a power plant on a site zoned for industrial uses can take advantage of existing natural gas, reclaimed water and wastewater pipelines, therefore be it

RESOLVED that the Menifee Valley Chamber of Commerce supports the development of Edison Mission Group's Peak-Load Power Plant in the Romoland region of unincorporated Riverside County.
