

New Solar Homes Partnership Workshop Agenda

The California Energy Commission Renewables Committee will conduct a workshop to discuss the design of the New Solar Homes Partnership on June 12, 2006. The purpose of this workshop is to solicit comments from interested parties on the *Draft Staff Proposal on the New Solar Homes Partnership* (Draft Staff Proposal). Notice of the workshop was publicly circulated on May 13, 2006, but did not include a workshop agenda. The Energy Commission is developing the New Solar Homes Partnership, a solar incentive program for new residential construction. The primary goal of the New Solar Homes Partnership is to help create a self-sustaining market for energy-efficient, new solar homes. Additional goals include home builders incorporating high levels of energy efficiency and high-performing solar systems as standard features and home buyers demanding energy-efficient, solar homes. The Energy Commission intends to provide financial incentives and non-financial assistance in the form of builder and market support to help create this self-sustaining market.
