SUBJECT: Native American groups in the vicinity of the SVEP which are most actively concerned about Cultural Resources			
<p>Ms. Bastian asked Mr. Fagelson which Native American groups would be most concerned about the potential for as-yet-undiscovered buried cultural resources at the project site. He identified two groups, the Pechanga and Soboba, and noted that the Pechanga have mapped the locations of their traditional territory and sacred areas.</p> <p>Ms. Bastian asked for the names and telephone numbers of contact persons for these two groups, and Mr. Fagelson provided this information.</p> <p>Mr. Fagelson conveyed what he believed would be the desires of these groups: that a Native American monitor all excavations at the site.</p> <p>Mr. Fagelson indicated that in the past there were many village sites in the area, and that even when there is no surface sign of Native American activities, buried deposits have been found. He cited a recent instance in which a Native American burial with a large quantity of grave goods was found 4 feet down in a field which had been plowed for many years, but which showed no surface indications of any kind of buried deposits. This find was located less than a mile from the proposed SVEP site.</p>
