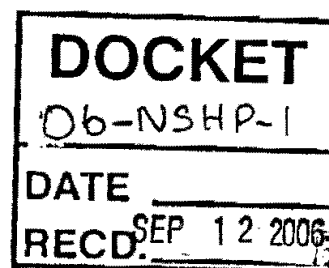

Background


