Responding to the Romoland School District's June 6, 2006 letter.

The Romoland School District has received a letter from Lawrence J. Kostrzewa, Managing Director, Development of the Valle del Sol Energy LLC to Mr. Skumawitz, Superintendent Romoland School District dated August 3, 2006. The purpose of this letter is to provide information in response to traffic concerns related to truck traffic that will pose a safety hazard to schoolchildren that are walking to school.

How many students walk from locations west of I-215 to Romoland Elementary School and what times of day are they present? 0

How many students walk from locations south of Ethanac Road to Romoland Elementary School and what times of day are they present? 0, however there are 56 students who reside south of Highway 74 and North of Ethanac that do walk and attend Romoland Elementary. These students must cross Highway 74 and are at risk with the increased traffic. Walking time for these students would be anywhere from 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m., 10:30 a.m. to 12:00 a.m., 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. and one day a week (Wednesday) 12:45 to 1:30.

Please describe any hazardous incidents that have occurred to date involving schoolchildren walking to school associated with the construction of the Inland Empire Energy Center, and please describe what mitigation, if any, that project is providing?

We are unaware of any hazardous incidents that have occurred to date.

Please describe what additional assistance is needed for the existing crossing guard at the intersection of Sherman and Ethanac Roads? A traffic signal at this intersection would greatly improve the safety conditions for our students.
