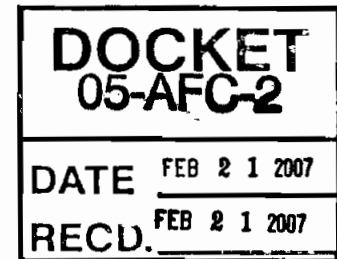

**COMMENTS:**

Staff spoke with Dr. Doug Davy of CH2MHill. Dr. Davy called staff to discuss proposed changes to language in CUL-7. Staff provided changes in language in response to changes requested by the applicant.

Staff explained that a change in language of CUL-7 clarified that the intent of the condition is to allow the CRS to recommend that the project owner retain a Native American monitor, if the CRS (based primarily on on-site observations) thought that a discovery of Native American artifacts was likely. Staff also explained that our intent is to have a Native American monitor on site when there is a discovery to act in the role of liaison with the Native American community particularly if there is a discovery of human remains. The Native American monitor would be available to assure the Native American community that discoveries, particularly burials were treated with dignity and respect.

Dr. Davy said that he could accept the proposed language.
