Project Title: Adoption of revisions to the *Renewables Portfolio Standard Eligibility Guidebook*

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: The purpose of this activity is to revise guidelines previously adopted by the California Energy Commission to govern the certification of renewable energy resources eligible to satisfy the state's Renewables Portfolio Standard pursuant to Public Resources Code section 25740 et seq. and Public Utilities Code section 399.11 et seq. The guidelines were revised to address changes in the law as a result of Senate Bill 107 (Statutes of 2006, Chapter 464), Senate Bill 1250 (Statutes of 2006, Chapter 512) and Assembly Bill 2189 (Statutes of 2006, Chapter 747), and to address regulatory and market developments. The California Energy Commission, operators and developers of renewable energy resources, and electric utilities benefit from the adoption of revisions to these guidelines.


