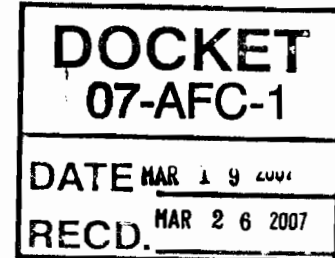

Re: Victorville 2 Hybrid Power Project Application for Certification

Dear Mr. Roberts:

The Mojave Desert Air Quality Management District (District) received an Application for Certification (AFC) for the Victorville 2 Hybrid Power Project (VV2) on March 13, 2007.

As a proposed new major facility, VV2 triggers offset requirements. As identified in the application, the applicant must provide the District with a proposed offset package containing evidence of 145 tons of NO_x ERCs, 45 tons of VOC ERCs, and 121 tons of PM₁₀ ERCs as offsets. This letter therefore serves as notice of the offset package requirement, as specified in Rule 1302(C)(3).

In accordance with Rule 1306, the District considers the AFC an application for applicable District permits. The District requires local permit applications and related application fees (including the Complex Source Project Evaluation Fee) to continue analysis of the proposed VV2. Based upon the AFC, the District will require permit applications for each:

- Combustion turbine power train (2)
- Auxiliary boiler
- HTF heater
- Duct burner (2)
- SCR and ammonia injection system (2)
- Oxidation catalyst complex (2)
- Cooling tower
- Emergency generator

This represents a total of 12 applications for air permit. Including the complex source fee required by Rule 301(C)(2), the required application filing fees total \$9044.


Upon receipt of the required permit applications and filing fees, the District will continue the analysis necessary to issue a Preliminary Determination of Compliance for VV2. The District will notify you of any issues or information that need clarification.
