RE: Colusa Generating Station


In response to your request, regarding the MFPD's requirements for the Colusa Generating Station, I am writing this brief summary of what we believe will accommodate our district, and best serve its community. In mitigating with Competitive Power Ventures it is apparent to me that they are trying very hard to work with us, and negate the impact of the plant. We appreciate this, however it needs to be noted that the impact upon the district will commence upon the approval of the project with the increase of company personnel and any funding from the county that we may receive will not transpire until the project is complete.

Secondly, it is a fact that the State is requiring more from the Fire Districts of California than ever. Training and equipment requirements are already at it's peak for this District and as we are also a volunteer station, manpower is really an issue, as most volunteer stations are finding everywhere.

According to the letter I received from the County of Colusa we will only be receiving approximately \$23,255 of the approximate \$5,000,000. in taxes per year, to the County and schools that will be generated by this project. According to my calculations, for increased necessity of manpower and equipment this \$23,255.00 is only about 10% of the funds we will require to negate the impact to the MFPD of the Colusa Generating Station. This funding amount and timeline will need to be mitigated in order for us to approve of the building of this facility.

Your cooperation in working with us in identifying and resolving this FPD's needs is much appreciated. The continued support and cooperation is a good sign that this project is a positive one for this community.
