Purpose


The California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) is currently analyzing Valle del Sol Energy, LLC's Application for Certification (AFC) for the proposed development of the Sun Valley Energy Project (SVEP). Staff published the Preliminary Staff Assessment (PSA) for the project on May 16, 2007.

The Energy Commission staff will conduct a Preliminary Staff Assessment (PSA) workshop for the proposed SVEP. The purpose of this workshop is to discuss the staff's PSA with the applicant and all parties including local, state, and federal agencies and the public. The workshop will provide an opportunity for the public and other interested parties to discuss the PSA and to provide comments to Energy Commission staff. All interested parties are invited to participate. Following the workshop, staff will consider the comments it receives and publish a Final Staff Assessment (FSA) containing staff's final recommendations on the proposed project. This will be followed by a draft decision prepared by the Committee presiding over this project titled the Presiding Member's Proposed Decision.

Background

On December 1, 2005, Valle del Sol Energy, LLC, submitted an AFC to construct and operate a 500 megawatt (MW) simple-cycle power plant, the SVEP, near Romoland in unincorporated western Riverside County. The facility site would be located on a 20-acre parcel owned by the applicant. The site is approximately 1.0 mile southeast of Romoland, 0.75 mile south of State Route 74, and 600 feet south of Southern California Edison's (SCE) Valley Substation located on Menifee Road. The Energy Commission is responsible for reviewing and ultimately approving or denying all applications for thermal electric power plants with a capacity of 50 MW and greater, proposed for construction in California. On February 1, 2006, the Energy Commission accepted the AFC as complete, which initiated the Energy Commission staff's independent review of the proposed project.

The Preliminary Staff Assessment (PSA) presents the Energy Commission staff's independent analysis of the Sun Valley Energy Project (SVEP) Application for Certification (AFC). This PSA is a staff document. The PSA describes the following:

- the existing environmental setting;
- · the proposed project;
- whether the facilities can be constructed and operated safely and reliably in accordance with applicable laws, ordinances, regulations and standards (LORS);
- the environmental consequences of the project including potential public health and safety impacts;
- cumulative analysis of the potential impacts of the project, along with potential impacts from other existing and known planned developments;
- mitigation measures proposed by the applicant, staff, interested agencies and intervenors that may lessen or eliminate potential impacts;
- the proposed conditions under which the project should be constructed and operated, if it is certified:
- · project alternatives; and
- the project closure requirements.

The 19 technical area analyses contained in this PSA are based upon information from: 1) the AFC; 2) subsequent submittals; 3) responses to data requests; 4) supplementary information from local and state agencies, interveners, and interested individuals; 5) existing documents and publications; and 6) independent field studies and research.


