Notice of Intent to Adopt a Negative Declaration

The California Energy Commission proposes to adopt a Negative Declaration, under the California Environmental Quality Act, for proposed Regulations Establishing and Implementing a Greenhouse Gases Emission Performance Standard for Local Publicly Owned Electric Utilities. The Negative Declaration is proposed to be adopted at an Energy Commission business meeting to be held:

Project Description and Location

The Energy Commission is proposing to adopt regulations that will prohibit California's local publicly owned electric utilities (POUs) from entering into long-term financial commitments for baseload power from generation facilities that exceed a numerical greenhouse gases emissions performance standard. The proposed regulations also include provisions that identify the types of power procurement commitments that are subject to the standard and establish a compliance evaluation and enforcement process. California's POUs import portions of their electricity from out-of-state generating units located within the Western Regional Coordinating Council (WECC) territory. Therefore, the proposed project could potentially have environmental effects within California and within the WECC territory. This territory includes all or part of 11 western states, 2 Canadian provinces, and Baja California, Mexico.


