**2. State and justify the length of time the Commission should keep the record confidential.**

Five years. As stated in item 3 below, the confidential information is commercially sensitive and a trade secret, and disclosure at any time in the future would have an adverse effect on the Applicant and its investors.

The completed forms requested by the Energy Commission contain information that is commercially sensitive, which the applicant considers to be confidential.
