SUBJECT: Native American groups which could be named Most Likely Descendents for the SVEP project, if human remains should be found.			
Ms. Bastian called Mr. Singleton to inquire as to which Native Americans the Native American Heritage Commission (NAHC) would designate as the Most Likely Descendent (MLD) for the Sun Valley Energy Project (SVEP), if human remains should be found there during construction.			
Mr. Singleton stated that both the Pechanga Band of Mission Indians and the Soboba Band of Mission Indians (both of Luiseño heritage) consider the Sun Valley project area to be their previous tribal territory. If the NAHC had to designate an MLD for the proposed SVEP site, it would ask each of these two groups to provide "compelling evidence" to substantiate their claims for the closest ties to the site and choose whichever made the best case. If neither could make a strong case, the NAHC would designate them joint MLDs for the remains.			
Ms. Bastian asked Mr. Singleton what facilities the Pechanga Band had for the curation of artifacts. Mr. Singleton stated that he had not been to their Cultural Center, but believed that it did not include a museum and that the Band did not have a Curator.
