

Subject: EASTSHORE ENERGY CENTER (06-AFC-6) STATUS REPORT 6

Pursuant to the Second Revised Committee Scheduling Order dated July 2, 2007, the following is staff's Status Report 6 for the Eastshore Energy Center (Eastshore).

Status of Preliminary Staff Assessment

The Second Revised Committee Scheduling Order dated July 2, 2007 identified that the Preliminary Staff Assessment (PSA) would be published on July 31, 2007. However, due to the volume of staff's work and workload conflicts, this date will not be met.

Specifically, the Russell City Energy Center (Russell City), an amendment to a project previously approved in Hayward by the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission), shares many land use and traffic and transportation (aviation safety) issues with the Eastshore project. The expedited review and hearing process required for the Russell City project, the interrelatedness of Russell City with the Eastshore projects, and potential for cumulative impacts have prevented staff from completing the Eastshore PSA. Given the close proximity of these two power plants and their locations near the Hayward Airport, the same staff have been working on the two projects. Russell City events during the week of July 16, 2007 required staff attendance in Hayward, which greatly reduced time for Eastshore work.

Staff has now published their recommendations on the Russell City project, and public workshops have been completed. Therefore, staff is available to focus attention on the Eastshore project. It is staff's estimate that the Eastshore PSA can be published by August 10, 2007.

Staff's Proposed Schedule

The following table summarizes the Committee's Second Revised Scheduling Order in comparison to the new projected schedule proposed by staff. Staff will strive to complete its analysis expeditiously and look for opportunities to condense the schedule to the degree possible.
