

Commission Approval of the 12/19/06 Petition to Eliminate the Use of San

Joaquin River Water for Cooling

Dear Mr. Allen:

On August 1, 2007, the Energy Commission approved Order 07-0801-2 allowing Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E) to eliminate the use of San Joaquin River water as the cooling water source for the Gateway Generating Station, and to complete ten associated project design changes at the project, including a wet surface air cooling (WSAC) system designed to augment the fin-fan cooling system for the closed-cycle cooling system when ambient temperatures exceed 80 degrees.

Please find enclosed a copy of the Energy Commission Order approving the Gateway Generating Station amendment petition that was heard at the California Energy Commission Business Meeting on August 1, 2007. The Order has been posted on the Energy Commission's website and was docketed on August 6, 2007. I have also enclosed a copy of the Notice of Decision that was filed with the Secretary of Resources and docketed at the Energy Commission on August 2, 2007.

PG&E is approved to start construction on the Gateway Generating Station, as modified by Order 07-0801-2, with the understanding that several conditions of certification have been amended, requiring additional information to be provided to the Energy Commission staff prior to specific activities approved in the enclosed Order.
