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EASTSHORE ENERGY CENTER'S STATUS REPORT

August 15, 2007

The following provides Eastshore Energy Center's ("Eastshore") update to the Committee on the status of the above referenced proceeding. This status report expresses Eastshore's continuing and ongoing concerns about delays in issuing the Preliminary Staff Assessment.

Preliminary Staff Assessment Delay

After numerous past delays in the release of the Preliminary Staff Assessment, Eastshore has been informed of yet another delay. Eastshore has been notified that California Energy Commission ("Commission") Staff would be unable to issue a Preliminary Staff Assessment until approximately August 17. Eastshore had previously expressed concern about schedule delays in its July 25th status report. At the June 6th Status Conference, Eastshore also expressed concern about the impact to the overall proceeding schedule of a post-July 31st Preliminary Staff Assessment. Eastshore reminds the Committee that Commission Staff agreed in the workshop on May 23rd that they had all of the information they needed to complete the Preliminary Staff Assessment. Therefore, the Preliminary Staff Assessment delay is not the result of any actions by Eastshore, yet further progress on the Eastshore project remains stalled. Eastshore understands that the delay in the release of the Preliminary Staff Assessment is due in part to the current workload faced by Commission Staff.

As the Committee is aware, Eastshore is under contract with Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) to provide power by a date certain. Despite actions PG&E may or may not have taken to ease online requirements for other projects, Eastshore remains subject to the obligations of its power purchase agreement with PG&E. Should the Commission decide to give

Eastshore a license for its proposed powerplant, Eastshore intends to fulfill its obligations to PG&E. Therefore, Eastshore is very concerned about current and potential further delays if workload issues are not resolved or if Commission Staff continues to postpone its assessment. It is Eastshore's fervent hope that the Committee will consider and implement any feasible measures to accelerate the schedule for the remainder of the proceeding.

Conclusion

Eastshore appreciates this opportunity to provide a status report to the Committee. Eastshore remains concerned about the delays in the Preliminary Staff Assessment and respectfully requests that the Committee consider and implement any feasible measures to accelerate the schedule.
