

STATUS REPORT #6 FOR THE SUN VALLEY ENERGY PROJECT (05-AFC-3)

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) Executive Board adopted a revised Rule 1309.1 (Priority Reserve Program) at its August 3, 2007 Board Meeting. On August 16, 2007, SCAQMD sent Valle del Sol Energy, LLC, a letter detailing the additional information regarding emission standards and revised modeling that will be required from the applicant prior to the completion of the Final Determination of Compliance (FDOC). The applicant is planning to submit this newly required information to SCAQMD by August 30, 2007.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency completed its action approving the SCAQMD's request for attainment status for carbon monoxide (CO) within the South Coast air basin. The final determination of Attainment was published in the Federal Register Volume 72, No. 91 Friday, May 11, 2007. This removes the need for the applicant to acquire emissions reduction credits for CO for the Sun Valley Energy Project.

Staff has been informed by the SCAQMD that it expects to issue the FDOC during September, 2007. Staff is now working towards the following revised schedule based upon this current information:
