Subject: **SAN GABRIEL GENERATING STATION PROJECT (07-AFC-2) STATUS REPORT 1**

Pursuant to the Committee Scheduling Order dated July 12, 2007, the following is staff's Status Report 1 for the proposed San Gabriel Generating Station (SGGS) Project.

### Current Issues and Activities for Resolution

Staff has been working through the discovery and analysis phases of the Application for Certification (AFC) process for the proposed SGGS Project. At this time, no issues have been identified.

### Schedule

The schedule could be affected if the South Coast Air Quality Management District is delayed in issuing a Preliminary Determination of Compliance. The Air District has indicated that at this time, it believes it will be able to issue the Preliminary Determination of Compliance in September, which would not contribute to any significant schedule delay. Staff will continue to work closely with the Air District to support the efficient processing of the SGGS application and analysis of air quality impacts. Overall, staff, the applicant and agencies will coordinate closely and strive to ultimately achieve a 12-month AFC schedule for the SGGS.

Due to scheduling conflicts and workload with staff, the "Data Response and Issue Resolution Workshop 1" will occur on September 6, 2007, instead of late August 2007.

The following table summarizes the Committee's initial schedule in comparison to staff's currently projected schedule. The schedule has been updated to reflect the actual time for processing data requests and assumes that it will not be necessary for staff to prepare, and the applicant to respond to, a second set of data requests.

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
