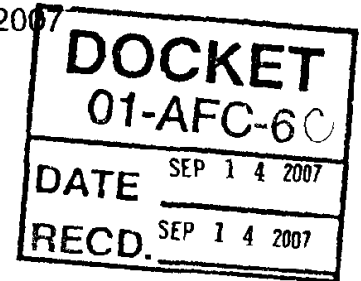

**Subject:** Approval of Petition for Additional Safety Platforms, Stairs and Ladders  
Magnolia Power Project (01-AFC-6C)

In accordance with the provisions of Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1769(a), California Energy Commission staff reviewed your petition received on August 9, 2007, requesting additional safety platforms, stairs and ladders. Staff determined that the petition met the criteria of section 1769(a)(2), and mailed the "Notice of Insignificant Project Change" to the Energy Commission's post-certification project mailing list on August 17, 2007.

The Energy Commission did not receive any public comments regarding this requested project change within the 14-day public review period as specified in section 1769(a)(2). Therefore, your requested modification is approved.

As requested by Southern California Public Power Authority (SCPPA), the City of Burbank shall act on behalf of the Energy Commission as Chief Building Official (CBO) for review and inspections for the addition of safety platforms, stairs and ladders. The project owner must provide a copy of the CBO's final inspection report for these project changes in the next Annual Compliance Report.
