

9/21/07 (11:25 am) Left voicemail message requesting a return call to clarify language in NOTAM. Mr. Rohring's voicemail message indicated he would be on vacation until 9/24/07.

9/25/07 (9:39 am) Mr. Rohring acknowledged that he was the originator of the first special security Temporary Flight Restriction(TFR)/Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) issued to address overflight and flight in proximity to power plants and other critical U.S. infrastructure following the 9/11 attack (now known as TFR/NOTAM 4/0811). He indicated that the size of the area subject to this NOTAM was intentionally left open for interpretation to allow flexible interpretation and enforcement of the advisory by the Dept. of Homeland Security, Federal Bureau of Investigation, or other security agencies. He also indicated that the normal size of these special security TFR/NOTAMs encompasses a three-mile radius and extends upward to 3,000 above ground level (AGL). However, the area encompassed by this TFR/NOTAM may be reduced or extended as necessary to address a particular concern or threat.

Mr. Rohring advised me that his office no longer handles these special security notices and referred me to Mr. Tal Hayley, of System Operations Security, for additional information regarding current enforcement of this advisory.
