On September 14, 2007, Cleantech America LLC (Cleantech) filed an application for confidentiality with the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) as part of its request for supplemental energy payment (SEP) funds. Specifically, Cleantech is seeking a designation of confidentiality for certain SEP documents. As part of this process, Cleantech is entering into a renewable energy contract with Pacific Gas & Electric (PG&E). On August 20, 2007, PG&E also submitted SEP documents seeking a designation of confidentiality.
