Jim was returning a phone message I had left for him earlier in the week. In that message, I had left some information about the results of the nitrogen deposition monitoring analysis that we had conducted, and the location of sensitive receptors (serpentine plant communities) in relation to the project area. Jim said that based on the information I had provided, he didn't think that the USFWS would have concerns that would lead to imposition of mitigation measures or assessment of significant impacts. However, he suggested that we communicate this information to his supervisor, Ryan Olaf, in writing. I noted that Ryan had received written information about this project in January of this year, and that I would check to make sure he was on the recipient list for notification of availability of the Final Staff Assessment.
