Subject: SAN GABRIEL GENERATING STATION PROJECT (07-AFC-2) STATUS REPORT 2

Pursuant to the Committee Scheduling Order dated July 12, 2007, the following is staff's Status Report 2 for the proposed San Gabriel Generating Station (SGGS) Project.

Current Issues and Activities for Resolution

Staff has been working through the analysis phase of the Application for Certification (AFC) process for the proposed SGGS Project. Staff is expecting the Applicant to provide additional information in early November 2007 on the blend of groundwater with reclaimed water at the existing site and the proposed blend that will be used for the proposed SGGS project.

Project Manager Transition

Some of the Siting Unit's project manager assignments are shifting due to a staff relocation. Felicia Miller will be the SGGS project manager beginning November 19, 2007. She can be reached at (916) 654-4640.

Schedule

The schedule will be affected by the South Coast Air Quality Management District's (SCAQMD) delay in issuing a Preliminary Determination of Compliance (PDOC). The SCAQMD previously indicated that it would be able to issue the PDOC in September 2007, which would not have contributed to any significant schedule delay. However, it now appears that the SCAQMD will most likely issue the PDOC in December 2007 at the earliest. Staff will continue to work closely with the SCAQMD to support the efficient processing of the SGGS application and analysis of air quality impacts.

In addition, the city of Rancho Cucamonga was expected to provide comments on the AFC by September as well. A preliminary set of comments and questions on land use, water resources, cultural resources, traffic, and hazardous material handling were not provided to staff until October 12, 2007. A final comment letter is expected from the city of Rancho Cucamonga in early November 2007.

The following table summarizes the Committee's initial schedule in comparison to staff's currently proposed schedule.

^{*} Staff's extremely high siting workload has lead to the air quality unit team addressing the SGGS, needing 30 days after PDOC receipt for completing an analysis. Legal and project management review of the analysis, plus document preparation time needed when multiple documents are produced each month, results in a PSA publication date of 40 days after receipt of the PDOC.
