I, and many other people who live or work in Hayward, are **strongly** opposed the power plants that the Calpine and Tierra companies are planning to build in our area. There is good reason to question the environmental impact information that these companies provided in seeking approval for these plants. Many of just don't feel safe, given the quality of the evidence.
