

## BACKGROUND

At the Prehearing Conference on November 26, 2007, Applicant, Staff, and Intervenors ("parties") indicated they were ready to proceed with the Evidentiary Hearing.

With the exceptions of air quality, public health, land use, traffic and transportation, environmental justice, alternatives, local system effects, and noise, the majority of technical topics are undisputed.

The primary dispute regarding land use and traffic and transportation is focused on the potential impacts to aircraft flying less than 1,000 feet above the Project's exhaust stacks near the Hayward Executive Airport. The Applicant has requested an "override" of applicable state and local laws on airspace safety arguing that (1) the Project would not cause adverse impacts to aviation and/or (2) certification of the Project is required for "public convenience and necessity" pursuant to Public Resources Code, section 25525. At the Prehearing Conference, we invited the parties to submit opening briefs by **December 7, 2007**, on the legal standard for determining whether "override" is appropriate in this case. The parties shall also have the opportunity to file post-hearing (reply) briefs to identify pertinent evidence in the record that would support their respective positions on the "override" issue.

Staff will sponsor witnesses from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (BAAQMD) to authenticate the Final Determination of Compliance and to be available for cross-examination on air quality issues.

### **EVIDENTIARY HEARING PROCEDURES**

The purpose of the Evidentiary Hearing is to establish the factual record necessary for a decision on the Project proposal. The record is developed by the presentation of sworn testimony and documentary evidence. As we announced at the Prehearing Conference, the parties shall file and serve written, sworn testimony as well as the qualifications of their witnesses to be received by **Friday, December 7, 2007**. (*See,* Cal. Code of Regs., tit.20, § 1224.) Testimony on undisputed topics shall be submitted by sworn declarations filed under penalty of perjury and offered into evidence by stipulation of the parties.

The parties' witnesses who appear in person shall be available for cross-examination. Each party sponsoring a witness shall establish the expert qualifications of the witness and ask the witness to summarize his or her prepared testimony before moving the testimony and relevant documents into evidence. At the conclusion of direct testimony, the witness may be cross-examined, followed by redirect and recross examination as appropriate. Multiple witnesses may testify as a panel, if warranted.

### **REQUIRED FILINGS**

The parties shall provide electronic copies of their written testimony, witness qualifications, documentary evidence, and Exhibit Lists to the Proof of Service list for receipt by <u>3 p.m. on December 7, 2007</u>. Written testimony for each witness shall be numbered as an Exhibit. Printed copies of the Exhibits (in the two formats described in the Notice of Prehearing Conference) shall be received by the Hearing Officer no later than <u>3 p.m. on December 7, 2007</u>. One printed copy of any Exhibit that has not been previously docketed shall also be submitted to the Docket Unit.

The rules of evidence pertaining to the Evidentiary Hearing are governed by Sections1212-1213 of the Commission's regulations. [Cal. Code of Regs., tit. 20, §§ 1212, 1213; see also § 1702 (h).]

The Applicant has the burden of presenting substantial evidence to support the findings and conclusions required for certification of the site and related facilities. [Cal. Code of Regs., tit. 20, § 1748(e).]

### PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

The deadline to file a Petition to Intervene in this proceeding was November 19, 2007. Robert Sarvey filed a Petition to Intervene on November 20, 2007. Although his petition was filed late, the Committee granted his Petition at the Prehearing Conference for the limited purpose of allowing Mr. Sarvey to present testimony and proposed Conditions of Certification on the topic of air quality.

### ORDER GRANTING PETITION TO INTERVENE

- 1. The deadline to file a petition to intervene was November 19, 2007, as noticed to all interested persons in the Notice of Prehearing Conference.
- 2. On November 20, 2007, a Petition to Intervene was filed by:

- 3. The Petition was not timely filed.
- Mr. Sarvey has participated in this proceeding for several months; his name and the responses to his comments are included in both the Preliminary Staff Assessment (PSA) and the Final Staff Assessment (FSA).
- 5. Mr. Sarvey offered no compelling reason for filing his Petition late.
- 6. The Applicant objected to said Petition on the grounds that it was filed late, that adding another party could delay the process; and that all the other parties met the deadline.
- 7. At the Prehearing Conference, notwithstanding the late filing, the Committee granted Mr. Sarvey's Petition in the interest of public participation.
- 8. The Petition contains the information required by section 1207 of the Energy Commission's regulations. (Cal. Code of Regs., tit. 20, § 1207).
- The Petition states that Mr. Sarvey wishes to limit his participation to the topic of Air Quality.
- 10. Petitioner's interests are relevant to this proceeding.

It is therefore ORDERED that the Petition to Intervene filed by Robert Sarvey be GRANTED for the limited purpose of presenting evidence on Air Quality.
