

Chabot-Las Positas Community College District and Chabot-Los Positas Faculty
Association (collectively "Chabot Intervenors") are not providing a brief on the legal
standards that the Commission should apply if the Commission determines to exercise its
authority to override applicable state, local, or regional laws, ordinances, regulations, and
standards ("LORS") based on their limited involvement in this proceeding in the areas of
environmental justice and socioeconomic impacts. At this time, the Chabot Intervenors are not
aware of any potential override by the Commission with respect to these areas.

If the Commission determines to exercise its authority to override LORS that impact schools in the areas of environmental justice and/or socioeconomics, the Chabot Intervenors assert that the District is entitled to a meeting and consultation with the Commission pursuant to Public Resources Code section 22523(d)(1). In addition, the Chabot Intervenors reserve the right during and after the Evidentiary Hearing to oppose and to provide briefing.
