# **Purpose**

California Energy Commission staff filed its PSA on the Humboldt Bay Repowering Project Application for Certification (AFC) on November **29**, **2007**. A PSA workshop was held on December **14**,**2007**. The purpose of this second PSA workshop is to continue dialogue with the applicant, public, and local, state and federal agencies, and to seek resolution of issues identified in staffs environmental and engineering analysis of the proposed HBRP as documented in the PSA. Discussion topics will **include** the following:

- <u>Land Use</u> reviewing recent coastal access improvements and assessing any additional needs for public use areas in accordance with the Warren-Alquist Act;
- <u>Cultural Resources</u> continuing discussions regarding the potential historical significance of the existing Humboldt Bay Power Plant and its consideration as a historic district;

- Air Quality ongoing discussion of updated modeling results and the HBRP's conformance with air quality rules and standards; status of Final or revised Preliminary Determination of Compliance; and
- <u>Public Health</u> continuing discussions and assessment of the potential for health impacts to the Humboldt Hill community from the use of diesel as a back-up fuel;
   PG&E's proposed alternatives to limit use of diesel fuel.

Results of the workshop discussions will be incorporated into the Final Staff Assessment, which will become **staff's** testimony in evidentiary hearings.

### **Background**

On September 29,2006, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) submitted an AFC to construct and operate a nominal 163 megawatt (MW) power plant consisting of ten natural gas-fired reciprocating engine-generator units rated at 16.3 MW each. The proposed project site is located at 1000 King Salmon Avenue, approximately 3 miles south of the City of Eureka, Humboldt County. The facility would be located on 5.4 acres within a 143-acre parcel currently occupied by the existing PG&E Humboldt Hay Power Plant. The Energy Commission is responsible for reviewing and deciding whether to approve an application for a thermal power plant, with a capacity of 50 MW or greater, proposed for construction in California.


