Purpose

The Energy Commission staff is currently analyzing MMC Energy Inc.'s (MMC Energy) Application for Certification (AFC) for the proposed development of the Chula Vista Energy Upgrade Project (CVEUP). Staff published data requests on November 7, 2007 for the following technical areas: Air Quality, Cultural Resources, Soil and Water Resources, and Transmission System Engineering. The staff workshop will focus on MMC Energy's December 7, 2007 data responses and work toward resolving project issues. MMC Energy has requested more time for responses to some of staffs data requests in the area of Transmission System Engineering as the Facilities Study and the California Independent System Operator's (CAISO's) new deliverability study are currently being completed. Following the workshop, staff will consider the comments it receives, if necessary submit a second round of data requests, and publish a Preliminary Staff Assessment containing a preliminary analysis of issues and recommendations for mitigation and conditions of certification.

Background

On August 10, 2007, MMC Energy submitted an Application for Certification (AFC) to,

of Chula Vista, San Diego County. The CVEUP would be a natural gas-fired simple cycle power plant and would have a nominal capacity of 100 megawatts. Primary equipment for the generating facility would include two General Electric LM6000 combustion turbine generators. The generators would connect to the existing 69 kV transmission line that currently serves the existing 44.5 MW Chula Vista Energy Project. If approved, the proposed project would be constructed on the northern portion of the existing 44.5 MW Chula Vista Energy Project site. As part of the proposed project, the existing 44.5 MW power plant would be decommissioned, dismantled, and removed.

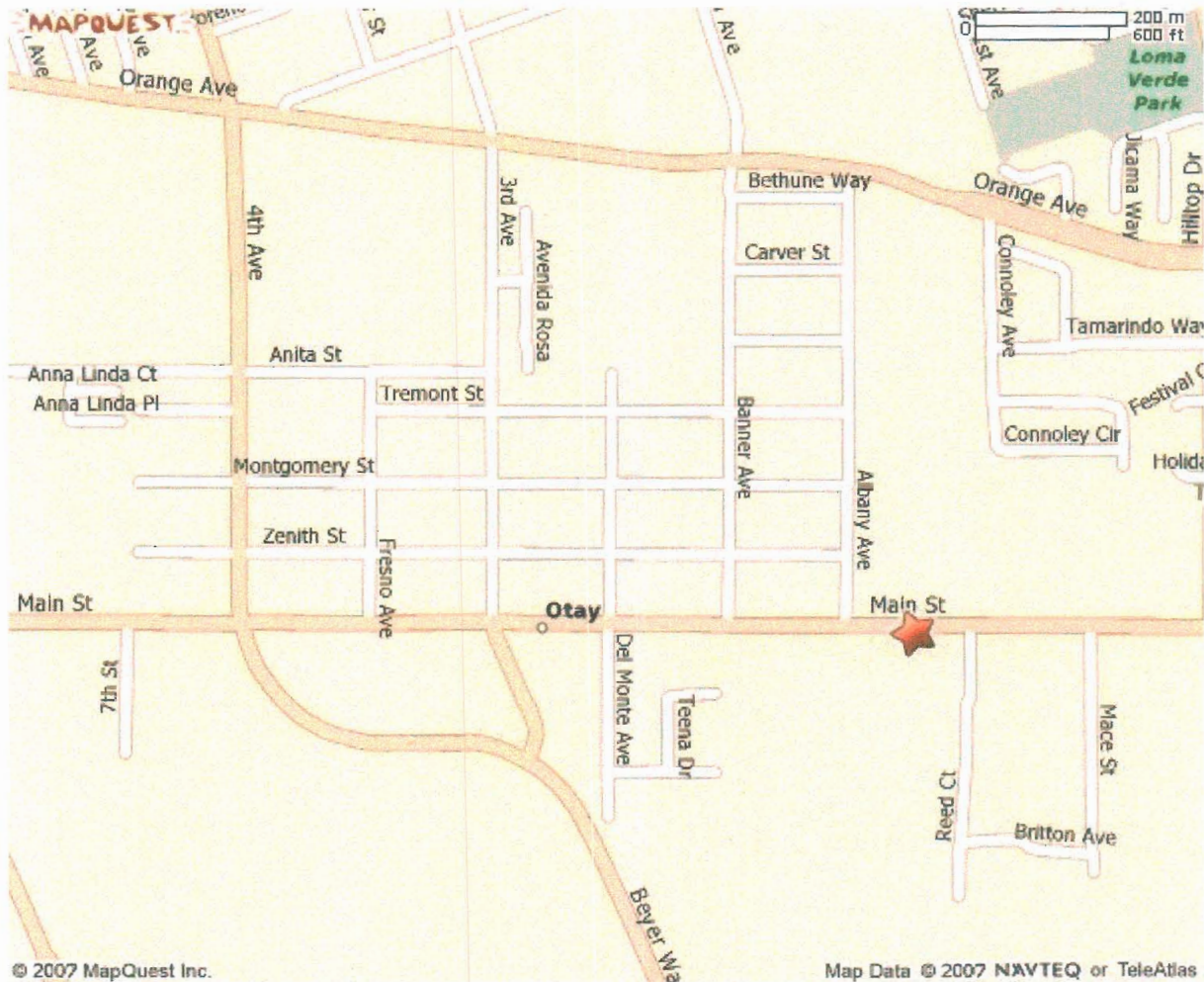
