It was nice talking to you a little while ago. I have the following response to your questions:

The SJVEC project has been withdrawn from the Cal ISO Generation Queue (Q #55) as of 11/13/07

Few other projects ahead of the KRCD project were also withdrawn from the ISO Queue but some of those projects were not modeled in the base cases and others were quite remote to have any significant impact on the results of the KRCD project. Withdrawal of the SJVEC project has a significant impact on the KRCD Interconnection System Impact Study (ISIS) results and a sensitivity analysis was performed to determine the impact without the SJVEC project. The ISIS report issued on 7/30/07 shows both those results with and without the SJVEC project.

The Interconnection Facilities Study is expected to be complete by early May 2008.
