

I left Joe Stenger a voicemail, followed by an email providing details about a 1/11108 meeting attended by myself and the cultural staff. The purpose of the staff meeting was to discuss the applicant's response to data requests and information in the supplemental and as a follow up to the issue of testing for cultural remains at the project site. My email to Joe discussed information provided by the applicant detailing field surveys and requested a more detailed paleological map indicating the type and depth of soils at the project site for the purpose of determining whether a testing plan could be developed.

Joe Stenger returned my call and we discussed the soils located at the project site. Joe provided details about the soil taxonomy and stated soil at project site is composed entirely of alluvium. The depth of bedrock is not a significant factor, as engineering to bedrock depths is not a consideration in this project. After our discussion, we decided it was not necessary for Joe to provide staff with a map detailing the type and depth of soils at the project site. I told Joe I would pass this information on to the cultural staff and encourage staff to provide TRC with a testing plan which would satisfy staffs requirements.
