

The 2008 Building Energy Efficiency Standards being reviewed by your Commission members this month contains a provision, which I request, be immediately deleted from the document.

The provision requires that new homes and commercial buildings be provided with Programmable Communicating Thermostats (**PCT's**). Further, the document states that if an "Emergency Event" is declared, a radio signal **will** be sent to all **PCT's** and the occupants air conditioning can be turned off, or the temperature of the building regulated by an outside entity.
