

This letter is in response to amendments proposed by the California Energy Commission (CEC) as required pursuant to Health and Safety Code (H&SC), Section 18930(a)(9), "The proposed building standard, if it promotes fire and panic safety as determined by the State Fire Marshal, has the written approval of the State Fire Marshal."

The State Fire Marshal reviewed the following proposed revisions to regulations to Title 24, Part 6, 2008 Building Energy Efficiency Standards:

- Subchapter 3, Section 121(c)(3)-Requirements for Ventilation,
- Subchapter 4, Exceptions to Section 131(a)-Area Controls,
- Exceptions to Section 131(d)-Shut-off Controls,
- Section 131(g)-Demand Responsive Lighting Controls,
- Subchapter 5, Section 143(a)-Prescriptive Requirements for Building Envelope,
- Subchapter 5, Table 147-B-Additional Lighting Power Allowance for Specific Applications,
- Subchapter 7 Section 150(o)-Mandatory Features and Devices.
- Subchapter 8, Sections 151(f)3,12-Fenestration/Roofing Products, Table 151-B,C,D,
- Subchapter 9, Section 152(b)1Hiia-Roof Deck Insulation or Ventilation,
- Subchapter 9, Section 152(b)1Hiic-Attic Ventilation and
- Residential ACM Manual, Section 3.4.4-Attic Ventilation.

As a result, the Office of the State Fire Marshal finds no conflict in the proposed changes and therefore, approval is granted.
