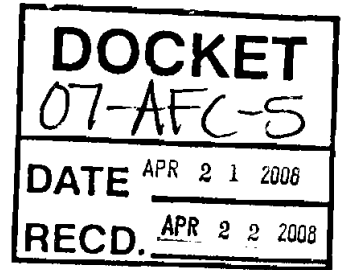

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
**JOINT STIPULATION REGARDING REQUESTS FOR ADDITIONAL
INFORMATION**

The Applicant, the Staff of the California Energy Commission (“Commission Staff”), and California Unions for Reliable Energy (“CURE”), collectively referred to as “the Parties”, jointly stipulate and agree as follows:


1. Section 1716(e) of Title 20 of the California Code of Regulations provides as follows: “All requests for information shall be submitted no later than 180 days from the date the commission determines an application is complete, unless the committee allows requests for information at a later time for good cause shown.”
2. The Ivanpah SEGS project was deemed Data Adequate on October 31, 2007.
3. April 28, 2008 is the date that is 180 days from the date the Ivanpah SEGS project was determined to be Data Adequate.
4. The Parties agree that additional time for requests for information without a required showing of good cause beyond April 28, 2008 is consistent with facilitating further public participation in this proceeding.
5. In reliance on, and subject to the stipulations above, the Parties agree that the April 28, 2008 deadline should be extended to June 2, 2008.
6. In reliance on, and subject to the stipulations above, the Parties further understand and agree that requests for information after June 2, 2008 may

be allowed by the Committee upon good cause showing as determined by the Committee pursuant to Section 1716(e).

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**ORDER REGARDING REQUEST TO EXTEND DEADLINE FOR REQUESTS
FOR INFORMATION**

Section 1716(e) of Title 20 of the California Code of Regulations provides as follows: "All requests for information shall be submitted no later than 180 days from the date the commission determines an application is complete, unless the committee allows requests for information at a later time for good cause shown." The Ivanpah SEGS project was deemed Data Adequate on October 31, 2007. April 28, 2008 is the date that is 180 days from the date the Ivanpah SEGS project was determined to be Data Adequate.

The Applicant, the Staff of the California Energy Commission ("Commission Staff"), and California Unions for Reliable Energy ("CURE"), collectively referred to as "the Parties" have jointly stipulated and agreed and the Committee concurs with the assessment of the Parties that additional time for requests for information without a required showing of good cause is consistent with facilitating further public participation in this proceeding.

CONCLUSION AND ORDER

The April 28, 2008 deadline for requests for information is extended to June 2, 2008. Further, after June 2, 2008, the Committee may, upon good cause showing, allow for additional requests for information pursuant to the discretion granted to the Committee in Section 1716(e) of Title 20 of the California Code of Regulations.


