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LARGE-SCALE SOLAR ASSOCIATION**

Pursuant to Rule 1.4 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the California Public Utilities Commission ("Commission"), the Large-Scale Solar Association ("LSA") respectfully files this Motion for Party Status in the above-captioned proceeding. Concurrently herewith, LSA and CalWEA are jointly filing Comments on Greenhouse Gas ("GHG") Regulatory Strategies for the Electricity and Natural Gas Sectors. LSA seeks leave to intervene to file its Comments on the GHG Regulatory Strategies for the Electricity and Natural Gas Sectors and to participate in future proceedings in this docket.

LSA is a non-profit corporation supported by members of the large-scale solar energy industry.<sup>1</sup> Several of those entities are currently parties in the proceeding, including Abengoa Solar, Inc., Ausra, Inc., and BrightSource Inc. LSA's members compete to sell power to the utilities pursuant to the Renewables Portfolio Standard ("RPS") solicitations.

As such, LSA intends to represent the interests of solar electricity generating companies that are competing to sell power to the utilities pursuant to California's RPS solicitations. The GHG issues directly affect California's RPS program, and solar electricity generators desire an

opportunity to participate in the process. LSA intends to become more actively involved in the proceedings going forward.


Thus, LSA has a strong interest in participating in this proceeding, and such participation by LSA will not prejudice any party.


