

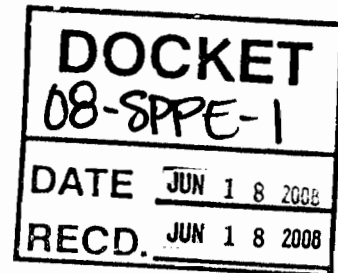

PROPOSED NEW POWER PLANT IN THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE

The California Energy Commission has received an application for a permit to build a new natural gas-fired power plant in the City of Riverside, in Riverside County. The project site is located in **T2S R5W, Section 31** on the "Riverside West" USGS quadrangle map.

A portion of the Energy Commission's permitting process involves notifying citizens and addressing their concerns.
