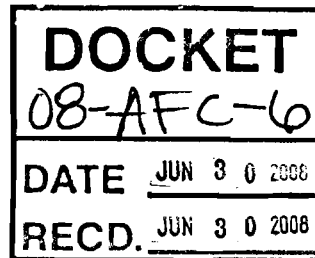

Mirant Willow Pass, LLC, an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of Mirant Corporation is pleased to submit the accompanying Application for Certification (AFC) seeking authority to construct and operate the 550 megawatt (MW) natural gas-fired Willow Pass Generating Station (WPGS).

The WPGS consists of two-275MW quick-start 1x1 combined cycle (Siemens FlexPlant10) units. The WPGS will be sited adjacent to the existing Pittsburg Power Plant in the City of Pittsburg, Contra Costa County, California. Brownfield development such as this is an excellent way to utilize existing infrastructure such as natural gas lines and electric transmission lines while preserving greenfield sites for other non-utility development. In addition to utilizing Best Available Control Technology, the project will incorporate LEED® design aspects for new construction.

We look forward to continuing our long-standing relationship with the City of Pittsburg and the surrounding local community as we develop the WPGS.
