PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY'S MOTION TO REOPEN THE EVIDENTIARY RECORD

PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY (PG&E) hereby petitions the Commission to reopen the Humboldt Bay Repowering Project (HBRP) evidentiary record for the limited purpose of allowing additional testimony and evidence in the areas of Project Description, Biological Resources and Soil and Water.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Final Staff Assessment (FSA) issued by CEC Staff on May 15, 2008, correctly states the HBRP will require a 401 Water Quality Certification. This permit is required by the Clean Water Act and administered by the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (NCRWQCB). In addition, the Water Quality Certification is also required under the California Coastal Act administered by the California Coastal Commission.

On June 17, 2008, the Committee held and concluded evidentiary hearings on the HBRP, and closed the evidentiary record.

BASIS OF MOTION

In accordance with Title 20 section 1754 of the California Code of Regulations the evidentiary record may be reopened upon the Commission's adoption of a motion to reopen or if due process requires, and upon fair and reasonable notice to all parties. PG&E hereby files this motion to reopen the evidentiary record and in addition to which believes due process requires the record to be reopened due to additional available information, reasonably unforeseen by PG&E requiring minimal project modifications. Since the close of the evidentiary record PG&E has worked to secure the requisite Water Quality Certification. In doing so the NCRWQCB has requested PG&E modify the project to include additional project features including a low impact bioretention pond to capture storm water run off. PG&E hereby requests the evidentiary record be opened to allow filing of written material describing and evaluating the proposed modifications which will be submitted by PG&E under separate cover. PG&E also requests the record to remain open to receive Staff's response to the material filed by PG&E.

CONCLUSION

PG&E hereby requests this motion be adopted by the Commission and the evidentiary record be reopened for the limited purposes described above.
