Dear Ms. Grenier,

Energy Commission staff commends the Colusa Generation Station (CGS) team for alerting the Commission to the need for temporary storm water control facilities at the project site and then presenting a sound solution. Your actions helped create a positive environment in which to work out the details so that the temporary storm water retention system can be in place at CGS before October 15th and the beginning of the rainy season.

Following our meeting on the issue on Thursday, August 28, 2008, staff reviewed the relevant Conditions of Certification in the CGS Final Decision and determined that staff approval is not necessary before work on the temporary system can begin. As we discussed in the meeting, the CGS submittal of the description, design calculations and water pollution control drawings for the temporary storm water control system will be made a part of the Commission's permanent record attached as an appendix to the already approved DESCP for the Colusa Generating Station.
