This letter is intended to respond to questions concerning Emergency Medical Services (EMS) for the Orange Grove power generation project (Orange Grove), proposed near the intersection of State Highway 76 and Pala Del Norte Rd. You asked that we supply a 'Will-Serve' letter.

The San Diego County Office of Emergency Medical Services awards exclusive operating area (EOA) franchises for the provision of medical assistance. The Orange Grove site is within the EOA awarded to Valley Center Fire Protection District (VCFPD); VCFPD has contracted this service to Mercy Medical Transportation, Inc., of which I am President.

We can confirm that Mercy is the EMS provider for the Orange Grove project site, and that we will indeed respond to medical emergencies for as long as we hold the contract. Any subsequent contract holder would also be bound to serve the project site – serving a parcel within an EOA is not optional.

The potential impacts from extending service to the Orange Grove site are expected to be minimal, due to the low number of employees expected to be on-site at any one time and the extensive safety features designed into the facility. As well, there are not expected to be any significant fiscal impacts.
