APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATION FOR THE CHULA VISTA ENERGY UPGRADE PROJECT

EVIDENTIARY HEARING ORDER

Parties wishing to present evidence or cross-examine witnesses at the Evidentiary Hearing scheduled for Thursday, October 2, 2008, at 10:00 a.m., Chula Vista City Hall, Council Chambers, 276 Fourth Avenue, Chula Vista, CA, shall be prepared to proceed in accord with this Order.

Background

At the Prehearing Conference on September 18, 2008, Applicant, Staff, and Intervenors ("parties") indicated they were ready to proceed with the Evidentiary Hearing.

Undisputed Topics

The parties agree that the following topics set forth in the Application for Certification (AFC) and the Final Staff Analysis (FSA) are undisputed and that evidence and testimony on these topics shall be solely by declaration (numbering corresponds to the Witness List, Exhibit A):

1. Executive Summary and Project Description; 2. Cultural Resources; 3. Hazardous Materials Management; 4. Soil and Water Resources; 5. Traffic and Transportation; 6. Transmission Line Safety and Nuisance; 7. Waste Management; 8. Facility Design; 9. Geology and Paleontology; 10. Power Plant Efficiency; 11. General Conditions, Compliance Monitoring and Facility Closure.

Disputed Topics

The following topics are disputed by one or more parties and the Committee will receive evidence in the form of written and live testimony, cross-examination and documentary evidence at the Evidentiary Hearing (numbering corresponds to the Witness List, Exhibit A):

12. Air Quality; 13. Public Health; 14. Socioeconomics; 15. Biological Resources; 16. Noise and Vibration; 17. Transmission System Engineering; 18. Power Plant Reliability; 19. Visual Resources; 20. Worker Safety and Fire Protection; 21. Land Use; 22. Alternatives.

Representatives from the **San Diego APCD** are requested to participate at the hearing and provide testimony on Air Quality.

Representatives from the **California Independent System Operator (CAISO)** are requested to participate at the hearing and provide testimony on the letter dated July 24, 2008, from CAISO to Jane Luckhardt, Counsel for Applicant, including but not necessarily limited to the topics, communications and correspondence referenced therein.

Staff and Applicant shall be prepared, and intervenors are invited, to present evidence and testimony on the disputed topics. Testimony, except for rebuttal testimony, shall be limited to those witnesses listed in the Prehearing Conference Statements and any supplemental materials filed as of September 30, 2008. Expert, as opposed to lay, opinion testimony will carry the most weight with the Committee. Staff, Applicant and Intervenors shall exchange copies of any documentary evidence not already provided in connection with the disputed topics, including, but not necessarily limited to, witness qualifications, no later than 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 30, and provide copies to the Committee, the Hearing Adviser, and those on the Proof of Service and mailing lists.

Staff is reminded of its obligation, set forth in the Notice of Prehearing Conference, dated August 22, 2008, to exchange, file and serve copies of any Conditions of Certification which have been revised since the publication of the Final Staff Assessment, in a format which clearly shows what revisions have been made, no later than 3:00 pm. on Tuesday, September 30, 2008.

This Notice includes the list of witnesses for each topic (*Attachment A*) and the exhibit list (*Attachment B*).

Required Filings

The parties shall file and serve copies of their supplemental written testimony, revised conditions, additional exhibits, and revised exhibit lists, no later than 3 p.m. on Tuesday, September 30, 2008.

The parties shall also provide electronic copies of the above-referenced filings to the Proof of Service list and to the Hearing Officer via e-mail.

Evidentiary Hearing Procedures

The purpose of the Evidentiary Hearing is to establish the factual record necessary for a decision on the Project proposal. The record is developed by the presentation of sworn testimony and documentary evidence. Testimony on undisputed topics shall be

submitted by sworn declarations filed under penalty of perjury and offered into evidence by stipulation of the parties.

The Applicant has the burden of presenting sufficient substantial evidence to support the findings and conclusions required for certification of the site and related facilities. [Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20, § 1748(e)].

The Committee will hear testimony by taking topics in the order set forth in the Witness List, Exhibit A. Any requests to change the order of topics should be submitted as soon as possible.

The parties' witnesses who appear in person shall be available for cross-examination. Each party sponsoring a witness shall establish the qualifications of the witness and ask the witness to summarize his or her prepared testimony before moving the testimony and relevant documents into evidence. At the conclusion of direct testimony, the witness may be cross-examined by the parties, followed by redirect and re-cross examination as appropriate. Multiple witnesses may testify as a panel, if warranted.

No time limits on testimony or cross-examination are being established at this time. However, the Committee may, at its discretion, request that testimony or cross-examination be curtailed if it becomes cumulative or in any other way unproductive, in the interest of completing the Evidentiary Hearing on October 2, 2008.

Public Participation

The Energy Commission allows members of the public and other interested parties to participate either on an informal basis or by intervening in the proceeding. Both types of participation allow written and oral comments. At the informal participation level, written and oral public comments are considered by the Commissioners and are part of the record, but are not part of the formal evidentiary record. Intervenors have the right to introduce evidence into the evidentiary record and cross-examine the other parties' witnesses.

Pursuant to the Power Plant Site Certification Regulations, California Code of Regulations, Title 20, Chapter 5, Section 1711, any person wishing to provide public comment in written or electronically recorded form in this proceeding, shall submit such materials to the Public Adviser no later than September 25, 2008. The Committee will then review the materials and specify such conditions on presentation of the materials as are reasonably necessary for the orderly and expeditious conduct of the proceeding.


