My name is Melissa Brito, I am the Closure Manager for the LAC Minerals (USA) LLC Colosseum Mine.

In reviewing AFC Figures 2 and 3, as provided at the California Energy Commission's Project Description website (http://www.energy.ca.gov/sitingcases/ivanpah/documents/figures/project_description), it appears that the proposed Ivanpah 2 feature will intercept the Colosseum Road.
