THE COMMISSION SHOULD ADOPT THE RPMPD

Group interveners California Pilots Association ("Calpilots"), San Lorenzo Village

Homes Association and Hayward Area Planning Association ("Hapa"), compliment the

presiding member's revised proposed decision ("RPMPD") and urge the Commission to fully
support the RPMPD properly refusing to override the numerous non-conformities with local and
state law. As briefed earlier by Group Intervenors, this project application additionally conflicts
with federal law relating to Hayward Airport's traffic patterns and operations, and as a matter of
law, must be rejected.

Without waiving those arguments, comments and modifications earlier proposed by

Group Intervenors, the County of Alameda and Chabot-Las Positas Community College District,
specifically those applicable to alternatives, public health, air quality and environmental justice,
among other sections, this Commission should adopt the RPMPD as proposed with the following
corrections which may be rendered under an errata:

Page 5, **Air Quality**: To mitigate PM emissions, Condition **AQ-SC8** requires the project owner to provide evidence of appropriate Emission Reduction Credits (ERCs) and/or woodstove/fireplace retrofit credits prior to *commencement of* construction.

Group Intervenors suggest this correction to avoid any arguments over what constitutes "construction," which may be subject to an interpretation consisting of conduct other than "breaking ground."

Page 8 continued summary of **Traffic and Transportation**: . . . The Committee rejected the results of the Barrick test as unreliable and denied Applicant's motion to reopen the record to allow seeking a second flyover to cure the deficiencies of the that Barrick test and to explore additional undefined "tests."

Group Intervenors suggest this modification to clarify that the applicant's motion was undefined, unclear, ambiguous and openended inviting a "fishing expedition."

Page 25: Findings and Conclusions: ... 2. As a result of PG& E's 2004 Request for Offers ... the Project Owner will operate the EEC under a 20-year power purchase agreement with PG&E . . .

As reflected on the subsequent pages, such as at pages 32 and 41, the applicant has admitted that this undisclosed executory contract was terminated on May 18, 2008. Therefore this finding should be struck as other references to it already have been struck or modified recognizing its non-existence. Group Intervenors further have consistently objected to any reference to this agreement that at the pre-hearing conference in November 2007 the applicant specifically refused to produce, even under a protective order, and stated it would not rely on this undisclosed contract in the evidentiary proceedings.

Group Intervenors further join in the County of Alameda's comments submitted today and compliment the Evidentiary Committee for their diligent hard work in reviewing this application.
