Introduction

Attached are supplemental responses (Set 1E) by Solar Partners I, LLC; Solar Partners II, LLC; Solar Partners IV, LLC; and Solar Partners VIII, LLC (Applicant) to the California Energy Commission (CEC) Staff's data requests for the Ivanpah Solar Electric Generating System (Ivanpah SEGS) Project (07-AFC-5). These data requests are the result of the workshop discussion held at Primm, Nevada on June 23, 2008. Within each discipline area, the responses are presented in alphabetical order and are numbered for tracking and reference convenience. New graphics or tables are numbered in reference to the Supplemental Data Request number. For example, if a table were used in response to Data Request AQ-1, it would be numbered Table AQ1-1. BR-4 Please provide any information available about repairs or pole replacement that would be needed to existing distribution line as part of the installation of the fiber optic line.

Response: Table BR4-1 and in Figure BR4-1 identify the kind and location of repairs to the Nipton 33 kV line, which will carry the fiber optic cable.



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
